

6.Jesus said there is one thing we need to be saved: We need to simply believe.

Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent." John 6:29

7.The amazing promise that is made many times is if we will believe, we will HAVE eternal life, not think, not hope but HAVE eternal life!

Everyone who believes in him may **have** eternal life. John 3:15

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but **have** eternal life. John 3:16

John 5:24 - Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life

Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me **has** everlasting life. John 6:47

Decision time:

Jesus healed a blind man and restored his sight. He later found the man and said, "Do you believe on the Son of God?" The man said, "Who is he, Lord that I might believe on him?" Jesus said, "You have both seen Him and it He that is talking to you." The man said, "Lord, I believe, and he worshipped Him."

At one point Jesus' disciples came to a place where they understood who He was and Jesus said,

"Do you now believe?" John 16:31

After seeing John's very clear teaching on eternal salvation, what will you do?

HOW TO BE BORN AGAIN

In the Bible, The Gospel of John was written for the express purpose to show us how we can be sure that we are going to heaven when we die.

John stated at the end of his Gospel that Jesus did many other signs
“But these are written, that you might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you might have life through his name “ John 20:31

The word “Believe” is found over 90 times in his Gospel. Every single page clearly shows who Jesus is and how we can be saved and have eternal life in heaven.

Look at **7** clear,

understandable statements from John’s Gospel on how we can be born again and be saved.

1.All of us have a clear need: We are sinners and need Savior.

This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but men loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. John 3:19

2.God has provided a Savior for us: Jesus came from heaven to die for us.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

3.God has made a great promise to us: If we come to Him he will not drive us away.

All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away. John 6:37

4.The biggest decision we will make in life is about this offer: Accepting or rejecting Christ.

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him. John 3:36

5.Believing in Christ is simple: Jesus compared coming to him like eating and drinking.

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty. John 6:35
